
UPCOMING SPECIAL EVENTS AT HOLT PARK

GROWING WILD: CREATING SEED BOMBS

Looking for a fun way to make memories and enjoy wildflowers? Look no further: all this is possible just by making a few seed bombs! But what *is* a seed bomb? Is dangerous? A seed bomb, also called a seed ball, is a bal of soil (usually clay) mixed with plant seeds and compos and then dried. The seeds are then easily distributed to different areas. ore	3. Add water and mix it together. You want the mixture to be thick but still moldable like clay.
5	4. Once you have the right consistency of your mixture it is time to shape it. Take as much of it as you want to roll into a ball. They can be as big or as small as you would like.
it	5. After you have rolled them out, line a tray with greaseproof paper and sit all your seed bombs on it to dry.
l st	6. Let them dry out for 4-5 days.
ly	After they are dry, you can go spread your seed bombs out into the world to grow.


